Under the referendum, voters must decide whether Section 3 of H.B. 545 should go into effect.</p> <p>Section 3 of H.B. 545 deletes the old provisions of the law regulating check cashing lenders, sometimes known as "payday lenders," in favor of the new provisions.</p> <p>1. If a majority of Ohio voters approve Section 3 of H.B. 545, all short term lenders, including check cashing lenders, would be subject to the following limitations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The maximum loan amount would be \$500;</li> <li>• Borrowers would have at least 30 days to repay the loan; and</li> <li>• The maximum interest rate would be 28% annual percentage rate (APR) on all loans.</li> </ul>		<p>2.
