CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT A

Shall the Utah Constitution be amended to:

- modify and clarify how a vacancy in the office of Governor is filled;
- define when a vacancy occurs in the offices of Governor and Lieutenant Governor;
- modify the term of office of a person filling a vacancy in the office of Governor or Lieutenant Governor;
- modify and clarify the exercise of the powers of Governor when the Governor is temporarily disabled;
- modify and clarify how the disability of a Governor is determined;
- modify how a vacancy in the office of Lieutenant Governor is filled; and
- establish a process for determining the disability of a Lieutenant Governor?

PROPOSITION #2

The Box Elder County Commission has adopted Resolution 07-24 which authorizes the sale of the Box Elder County Landfill and related property leases, easements and rights-of-way to the Northern Utah Regional Landfill Authority ("NURLA"). The stated purpose of the sale is to establish a solid waste management facility at the site of the current landfill, which would be jointly owned, maintained, operated and utilized by Logan City, Box Elder County, Wasatch Integrated Management District and Weber County, the current members of NURLA. PROPOSITION #8

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Box Elder County, Utah, acting as the governing body of the Central Box Elder Fire Special Service District, Box Elder County, Utah (the "District") be authorized to levy a tax on the taxable property in the District in the annual amount of \$113,000 for operations and maintenance expenses of the District, such as fire fighter expenses, fuel, etc.?

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE DUE TO TAX LEVY
Passage of the proposition means that the tax on a \$137,500 residence, which is the approximate average value of a residence in the District, would increase as much as \$47 per year. The tax on a business having the same value as the approximate average value of a residence in the District of \$137,500 would increase as much as \$86 per year.

In the event a property tax is not approved, charges for fire services may still be levied through the communities of Bear River City, Corinne City, Town of Deweyville, Town of Elwood, and Honeyville City.

PROPOSITION #9

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Box Elder County, Utah, acting as the governing body of the Central Box Elder Fire Special Service District, Box Elder County, Utah (the "District") be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the amount of not to exceed \$950,000 (the "Bonds") for the purpose of financing the costs of acquisition and construction of capital improvements, including fire stations, fire trucks and equipment and related fire safety improvements, and for payment of expenses reasonably incurred in connection with authorization and issuance of the Bonds; the Bonds to have a final maturity date of not to exceed 30 years from issuance?

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE DUE TO BOND ISSUANCE

Passage of the proposition means that the tax on a \$137,500 residence, which is the approximate average value of a residence in the District, would increase as much as \$32 per year. The tax on a business having the same value as the approximate average value of a residence in the District of \$137,500 would increase as much as \$58 per year.
